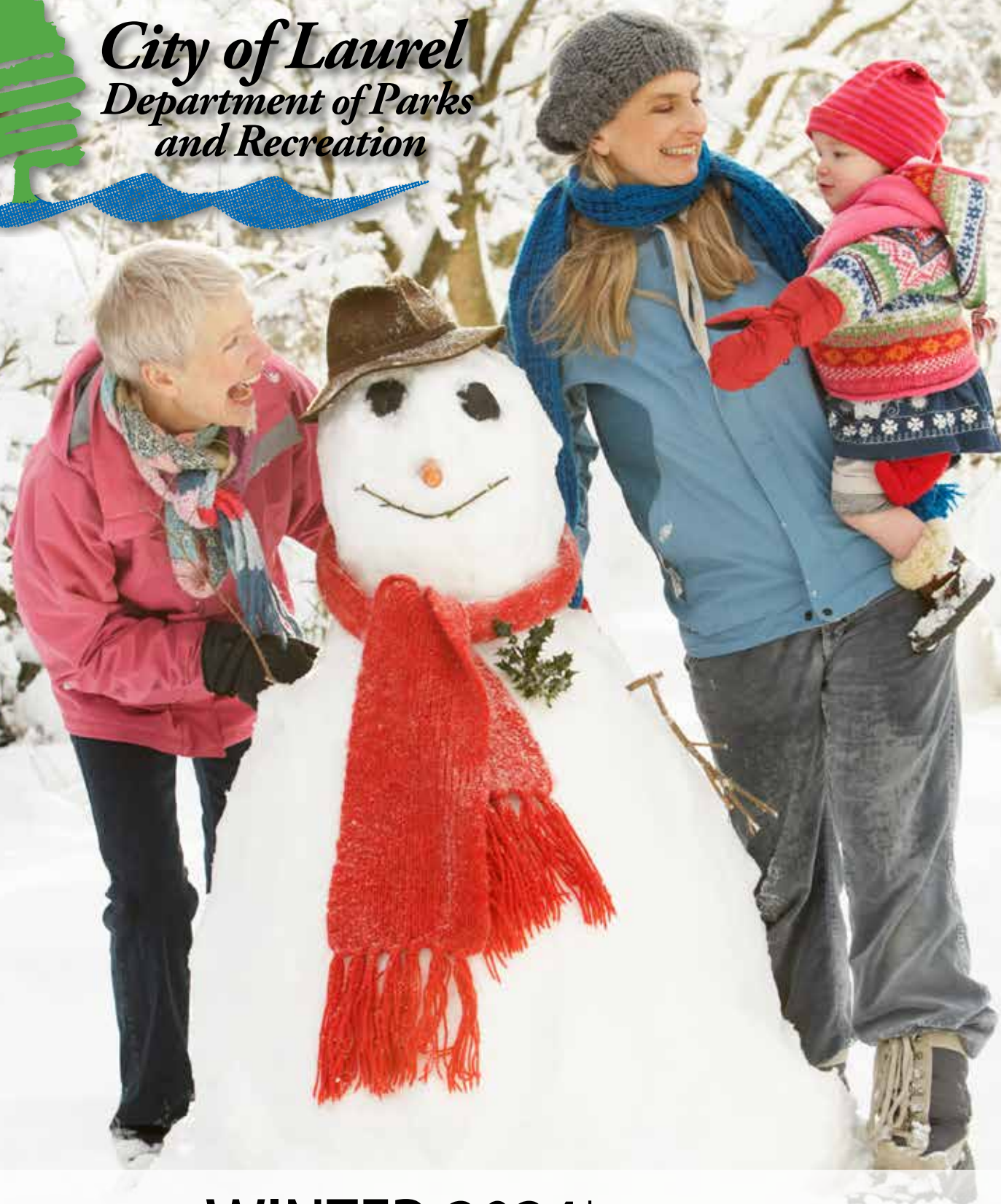

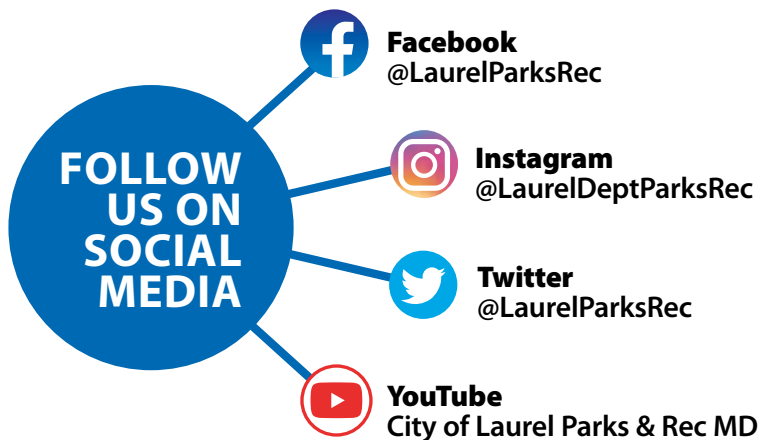

Internet registration is available for some programs once your account has been created. We strongly encourage new customers to visit one of our community centers to create an account. You must be registered to participate, unless a program listing states that no registration is required. Registration will be accepted through the first week of class if space is available. The City of Laurel Department of Parks and Recreation welcomes the participation of individuals with disabilities into all programs. The City will fully comply with the American with Disabilities Act in making reasonable accommodations to encourage participation.

**Fees** Checks are only accepted for certain activities. Persons paying City of Laurel property taxes pay resident fees. Fees include materials unless otherwise noted. No fee reductions will be made for missed classes.

Scholarships are available for low-income City resident families for some programs. The City also offers vouchers for low income City resident families that may be used towards recreation programs for children, youth and teens with other agencies. 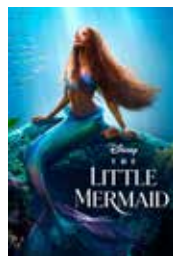

## DEPARTMENT OF PARKS & RECREATION'S MULTIPURPOSE RESOURCE CENTER GYMNASIUM

Located at 204 Fort Meade Road, this new gymnasium has six multi-positional backboards, a dividing curtain, two scoreboards and multipurpose vinyl flooring allowing for multi-use sports and multi-functional events. The gymnasium can be utilized as a rental space, sporting event, or fundraising event. Renovations also include two storage rooms for gym equipment and emergency supplies for the Department of Community Resources and Emergency Management (CREM).

This site could be setup as an evacuation site in the event of a City emergency if needed. Other spaces in this center include two multipurpose rooms, one upstairs and one downstairs. Both of these rooms have similar vinyl flooring found in the gymnasium allowing for multi-purpose use.

The Multipurpose Resource Center Gymnasium will promote physical wellness, competition and fair play.
