

What is the Homeowners' Property Tax Credit Program?

It's a program which allows credits against the homeowner's property tax bill if the property taxes exceed a fixed percentage of the person's gross income.

What is the Homestead Credit?

To help homeowners deal with large assessment increases on their primary residence, state law has set limits on the increase in taxable assessments each year to a fixed percentage.

What is the Renters' Tax Credit Program?

It provides property tax credits for renters who meet certain requirements. The concept rests on the reasoning that renters indirectly pay property taxes as part of their rent and thus should have some protection, as do homeowners.
